

## UPCOMING EVENT IN COLORADO

We're looking forward to welcoming our RIBA-AIA friends and colleagues to beautiful Colorado in August of next year. We are planning a spectacular week of golf, sight-seeing, architecture, art and socializing that you won't want to miss.

### Boulder

Our week will start the afternoon of Sunday August 16 in Boulder, Colorado, which is about 30 minutes north of Denver and a 45 minute drive from Denver International Airport. Boulder is a charming town set against the Flatirons (scenic red-rocked cliffs that form the foothills of the Rocky Mountains), and home to the University of

Colorado, known as one of the country's most beautiful campuses. We will be staying at the Hotel Boulderado, a landmarked historic property and the first luxury hotel built in Boulder. The Boulderado is just one block away from the Pearl Street Mall, Boulder's main pedestrian thoroughfare. Lined with interesting shops, bars, restaurants and music venues, and frequented by all kinds of street performers, the Mall is arguably the best people-watching site in all of Colorado. For those who want to explore areas outside the center city, Boulder is also close to Rocky Mountain National Park, and lots of great areas for hiking, biking and sightseeing are nearby.





## Denver

On Wednesday we will move to downtown Denver, where we will stay at the ART, a hotel. This hotel is adjacent to Denver's Civic Center Park, a Beaux Arts gem from the City Beautiful period, where the State Capitol and City Hall are located. What makes the ART most unique is its location in the center of Denver's museum district, where architectural gems abound including the Denver Art Museum (original building by Gio Ponti alongside a 2006 building by Daniel Libeskind), the Clyfford Still Museum (by Brad Cloepfil of Allied Works), the Vance

Kirkland Museum (by Olson Kundig), as well as other nearby museums in close proximity to the Denver Public Library designed by Michael Graves. The ART itself offers a museum-like experience, with its gallery-like public spaces displaying works of national and internationally-known artists. Also, for those who want to experience the true "vibe" of Denver, the ART is a short trip to Lower Downtown and the Union Station neighborhood, where much of Denver's most recent development is transforming the city into a truly unique urban setting.

## Golf

Colorado's sunny weather and amazing scenery will make our golf outings all the more memorable. Though most of our specific outings are still in the planning stages, we do plan to visit a number of courses that will offer true variety, from courses in mountain-like settings to links-inspired layouts set in the plains. Our rounds will take place in the morning hours, allowing time in the

afternoons for relaxation and other activities. Our itinerary includes 18 holes on Monday as a practice round, and tournament rounds on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, with optional golf on Wednesday. Our format will be similar to previous years, with fourball matches on Tuesday and Thursday and the Singles matches on Friday.

## Potential Activities for Non-Golfers:

*Nothing is finalized, but our current thoughts include the following optional activities:*

- Tour of Boulder's Pearl Street Mall – a delightful pedestrian street designed by Hideo Sasaki in the 1970's.
- For the active-minded: Hikes or bicycle rides of Boulder trails
- Bus tour to Rocky Mountain National Park

- Tour of Denver's museum district, which hosts the Denver Art Museum, the Colorado History Museum, the Clyfford Still Museum, and the Vance Kirkland Museum.
- Tour of Denver Botanic Gardens - one of the more significant Botanic Gardens in the country.

- Group dinner on Monday or Tuesday night in Boulder – location to be determined.
- Wednesday afternoon: Tour of LoDo (the Lower Downtown district of Denver), the center of activity in downtown, including Union Station, Denver's newly renovated historic train station which is now a transit hub.
- Wednesday evening: Private reception at the Martin Museum Residence – an

apartment residence designed by Daniel Libeskind, and housing works of artists such as Still, Calder, Stella, Warhol, Flavin, deKooning and others. This private residence is located directly across from the Denver Art Museum and offers stunning art and inventive architecture - a combination that will make this a very special evening.

- Thursday evening: Venue selection meeting for the 2022 event in the UK.
- Friday night: Awards banquet at the ART.


